## How Does Homebound Services Work?

If you are having challenges getting to the Library, we are as close as a phone call away, with our Homebound Services. We are happy to deliver monthly selections of books, audiobooks, music, magazines, puzzles, information, and more to our residents of Woodbury. The materials are selected for you, placed in a library book bag, and will be ready for pick up by your designated delivery person.

## Does The Library Deliver?

The Library has volunteer drivers who can deliver books to our homebound patrons. Please ask about setting up this service when you apply. You can also contact the Woodbury Senior Center at 203-263-2828 for assistance with delivery.

## How Long Can I Keep The Items?

All materials will be checked out to your Woodbury library card for a 21-day loan period. If you do not have a library card, and are a current Woodbury resident, we will issue you one. The materials must be returned within the designated loan period, and while you are exempt from overdue fines, you will be responsible for the replacement cost of any lost or damaged materials.

## Am I Eligible For Homebound Services?

If you are homebound, live in Woodbury, and are a Woodbury library card holder in good standing, you can use our service. Those who are temporarily homebound are also eligible.



## How Do I Apply?

Please fill out the application on the back of this brochure or call us at 203-263-3502 and we can take your application over the phone. Completed applications can be mailed to the Library. After your completed application has been received, someone from the library will be in touch with you to discuss your reading and listening preferences and help you with your selections. Your bag will be created for you and will be ready for pick-up the same day.
